# **Information for Parents – April 2024**

### Return to School Dates - August 2024

- 1. The return to school dates in August 2024 are;
- Thursday August 22<sup>nd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> years 9 to 11
- Thursday August 22<sup>nd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> years 9 to 12:30
- Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> years 9 to 11 (first day of school for incoming 1<sup>st</sup> years)
- Monday August 26<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years 9 to 11
- Tuesday August 27<sup>th</sup> Full school day for all students, including TY's first day back.

The finish up dates for the current school year are on the calendar, which is on the school website <a href="https://www.droghedacbs.ie">www.droghedacbs.ie</a>.

#### **PE Uniform**

2. The PE kit is compulsory for all students in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, TY & 5<sup>th</sup> year in the 2024/2025 school year. The PE kit is worn in PE class and exam PE classes at Leaving Certificate. The PE uniform cannot be worn in mainstream classes. The PE kit can be purchased from Playr-Fit using the link on the home page of the school website www.droghedacbs.ie.

Playr-Fit will be in the school on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 13th for fittings. Students can come in on any of those days and try on the various sizes of each item to make sure that the order is correct.

#### **School Uniform**

3. Details of the school uniform are on the school website <a href="www.droghedacbs.ie/uniform">www.droghedacbs.ie/uniform</a>. The school coat is a compulsory part of the school uniform, that all students are required to have.

Non school jackets/hoodies etc are not permitted on the school premises. Non school jackets/hoodies will be confiscated and returned to a parent.

School shoes are all black/brown/grey, or navy. No stripes, or markings are permitted on school shoes.

#### **Gaelic Football**

4. Louth GAA have offered to work closely with St Joseph's to achieve 'A' status for senior Gaelic football. This will see additional external coaches allocated to the school and upskilling of coaches in the school. We have been asked to raise €5,000 for this. If your son/daughter plays Gaelic in the school, we are asking you, or your company/business to make a donation if you are in a position to do so. #### **Schoolbooks Grant**

5. The government have introduced a new scheme which means that all school textbooks/novels/plays etc are paid for by the grant. The scheme does not cover the cost of the school ipad, uniform, pencil case, or school bag.

Parents will no longer have to pay the €100 book rental fee in either, first, second, or, third year. That has now been abolished.

## Ipads for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Years

- 6. The rollout of ipads for all students will enter it's 3<sup>rd</sup> and final year in August. All incoming 1<sup>st</sup> years and Transition years are required to purchase the ipad from Select. The link to Select and the code that is needed to purchase the ipad are on the home page of the school website <a href="www.droghedacbs.ie">www.droghedacbs.ie</a>.
  - May 17<sup>th</sup> the last date that the ipad can be purchased.
  - June 4<sup>th</sup> 1pm to 4pm set up date in the school for 3<sup>rd</sup> years. Select visit the school and set up the ipad onsite. Parents will be sent a time slot closer to the date.
  - June 5<sup>th</sup> 5pm to 9pm set up date in the school for incoming 1<sup>st</sup> years. Select visit the school and set up the ipad onsite. Parents will be sent a time slot closer to the date.

#### **New School Timetable**

- 7. The Board of Management has approved a change to the school timetable. The following changes are taking place from August;
- We are moving from 40-minute classes to 1-hour classes from August.
- Classes will begin at 8:30 each day, Monday to Friday.
- Lunch Break will be 30 minutes long. We will continue to operate a split small break and lunch. Small break will remain at 15 minutes.
- School will finish at 3:15 on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. School will finish at 12:45 on Fridays.
- The finish time on Tuesday is still being clarified and the finalised timetable will be published to parents next week.
