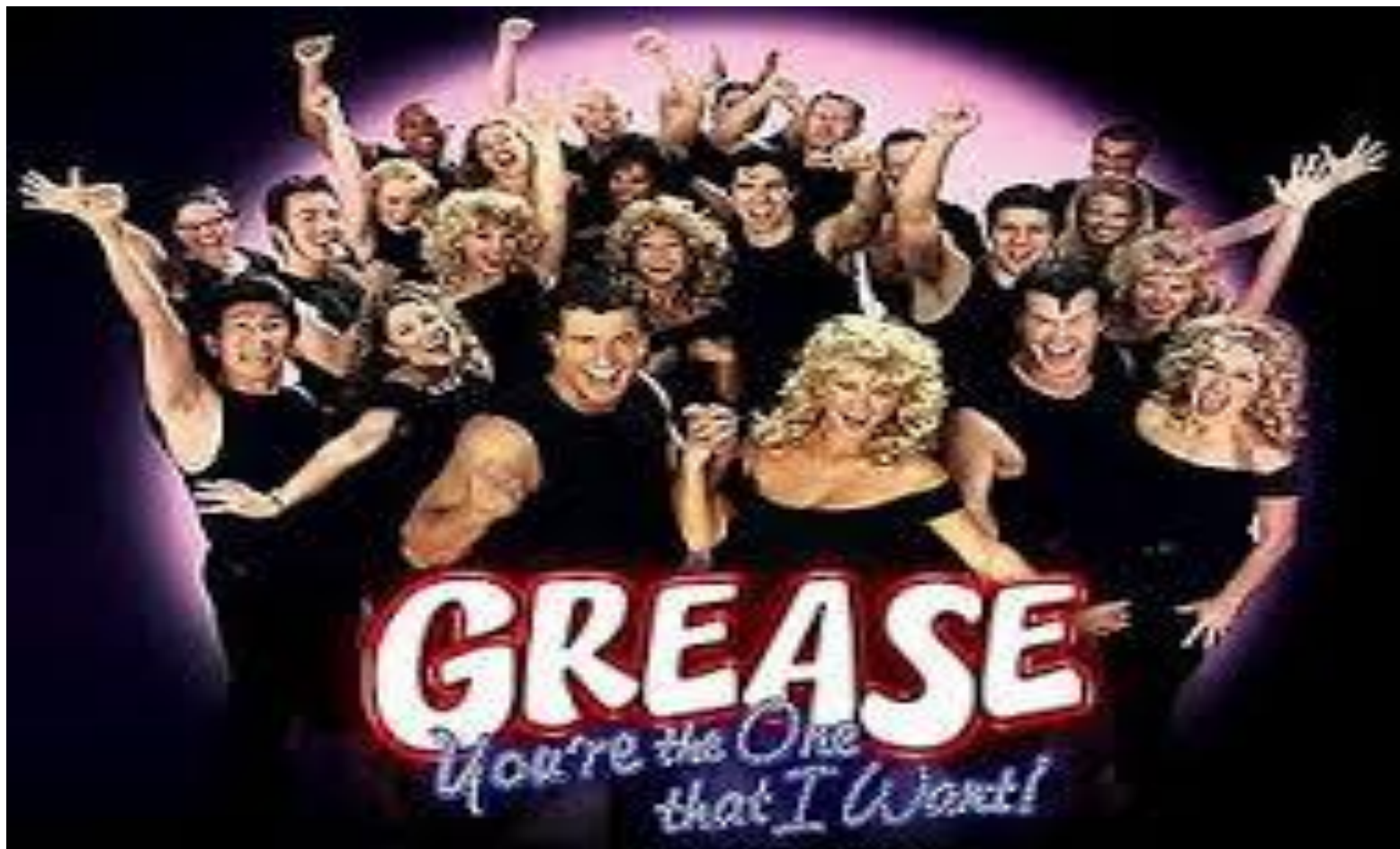
Transition Year
