LEAVING CERT PLUS



WHAT IS LCVP/LEAVING CERT PLUS

- **LCVP was introduced in 2018 in St Joseph's CBS. It is a two-year course incorporating enterprise, the world of work and career planning. We currently have one classes in 6th year and one class in 5th year. The students are timetabled for three periods per week. The LCVP class takes place in the computer room as there is a big emphasis on computer and work processing skills in LCVP. An outline of the LCVP plan is below.**

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR LCVP

- Programme Requirements for students:
- At least five Leaving Certificate subjects, one of which must be Irish **plus** the Link Modules
- Link Modules: Preparation for the World of Work and Enterprise Education (in addition to Five subjects)

ASSESSMENT OF LCVP

- LCVP students follow the same subject syllabi and are assessed in the same way as their peers in the Leaving Certificate. For the Link Modules they are assessed by Written Examination (40%) and by Portfolio of Coursework (60%).
- The Portfolio of coursework must be submitted on the first Wednesday in March. The written examination takes place the first Wednesday in May of the Leaving Certificate Year.
